I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act), received by the Education Directorate on 21 September 2018, in which you sought access to documents relating to the finding of asbestos at ACT public schools during 2018 and the subsequent management of the sites where the material was found. On 25 September 2018 it was confirmed with your office that the information being sought relates to Harrison School.

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General of the Education Directorate under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

Decision on access

The information you have requested forms part of the material being considered by WorkSafe ACT in relation to this matter. I am satisfied that release of the information at this time could prejudice the investigation in accordance with schedule 1, section 1.14(1)(a) of the Act.

As a result, I have decided to refuse access to the information you have requested as the release of documents is contrary to the public interest under schedule 1 of the Act. This decision is in accordance with section 35(1)(c) of the Act.

Ombudsman review

My decision on your access request is a reviewable decision as identified in Schedule 3 of the Act. You have the right to seek Ombudsman review of this outcome under section 73 of the Act within 20 working days from the day that my decision is published in the Education Directorate's disclosure log, or a longer period allowed by the Ombudsman.

Under section 84 of the Act, if a decision is made under section 82(1) on an Ombudsman review, you may apply to the ACAT for review of the Ombudsman decision.

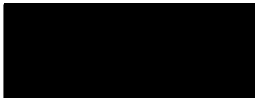
