"I get scared when I go to new places too. Do you know what helps me?" asked Mum.




"Talking about what it will be like and practising getting ready," explained Mum.

a change of clothes, just in case "On the first day, I'll take you in the morning. I'll give you a big, squishy cuddle and blow you a kiss."




"And I'll catch it!" said Otto.
