

Corrigenda to the Education and Training Directorate's Annual Report 2011-2012

On pages v, 7, 153 and 157 of the Annual Report, 95 percent of (or 53 of 56) Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students were reported to have received a Year 12 Certificate in 2011. The correct percentage is 80 percent and the correct number is 45 (of 56) students.

In the second paragraph on page 157 of the Annual Report, 53 Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students were reported to have received a Year 12 Certificate with eight of these students receiving a VET Certificate as well. The correct description is '45 Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students received a Year 12 Certificate with eight of these students receiving a VET Certificate as well'.

The data in Table C21.2 in the Annual Report was reviewed and required correction. The revised data for Table C21.2 on page 157 of the Annual Report is as below:

In addition, on page 50 of the Annual Report, the percentage of year 12 students receiving a nationally recognised vocational qualification in 2011 was transcribed incorrectly as 60 percent. The correct percentage of 64 percent was reported in the Statement of Performance 2011-12 on page 326 in the Annual Report. The correct figure for page 50 is 64 percent.
